Our Preschool Child Safety Policy

Our Commitment to Safety

The safety of our children is our top priority. We are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all children to learn and grow. In order to demonstrate our plans to safeguard your child while in our facility, we have implemented a comprehensive safety policy that covers all aspects of child safety, including:

- **Supervision:** All children are supervised by qualified staff at all times. Staff are trained to recognize and respond to potential hazards.
- **Environment:** The preschool environment is kept clean and free of hazards. All equipment is inspected regularly and repaired or replaced as needed.
- **Health:** We have a strict policy for preventing the spread of illness. Children who are sick are not allowed to attend preschool.
- **Stranger Danger:** We teach children about stranger danger and how to stay safe.
- **Fire Safety:** We have a fire drill plan in place and all staff are trained in fire safety procedures.
- **Emergency Procedures:** We have an emergency plan in place in case of a fire, natural disaster, intruder or other emergency.

It is our intention to provide a safe and nurturing environment for all children in our care. If you have any concerns about your child's safety, you are always welcome to bring them to the attention of our staff.

Specific Safety Policies

In addition to our general safety policy, we have specific policies in place for certain areas of safety, such as:

- **Medications:** All medications must be brought to school in the original container with the child's name and dosage clearly marked. Medications must be administered by a staff member who has been trained in medication administration.
- **Food Allergies:** If your child has a food allergy, please notify the school so that we can take the necessary steps to prevent your child from coming into contact with the allergen. We need a doctor's note on how and when to administer your child's medicine.
- **Medical Emergencies:** In the event of a medical emergency, we will call 911 immediately. We have a first aid kit on site and members of our staff are trained in CPR and first aid.
- **Communication:** We communicate regularly with parents about safety issues. This includes sending messages on Class Dojo and Procure, holding parent-teacher conferences, and making announcements at pickup and drop-off time.
- **Drop off & Pick Up:** We use a drop off and pick up line daily. Please help ensure your child gets to the sidewalk safely and meet your child at your vehicle at pick up. All new pick up members will need a valid ID and a message to the teacher with the name of the person allowed to pick your child up. Please place your child's name in the window on a piece of paper so we can have a quick, smooth transition.
- **Sign in and Sign out:** Please use the Procure app to sign in and out when your car is in park or within 200 yards of the building. All children must be signed in and out daily.

We understand that safety is a shared responsibility. As such, we constantly strive to work closely with parents to keep our children safe. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.
